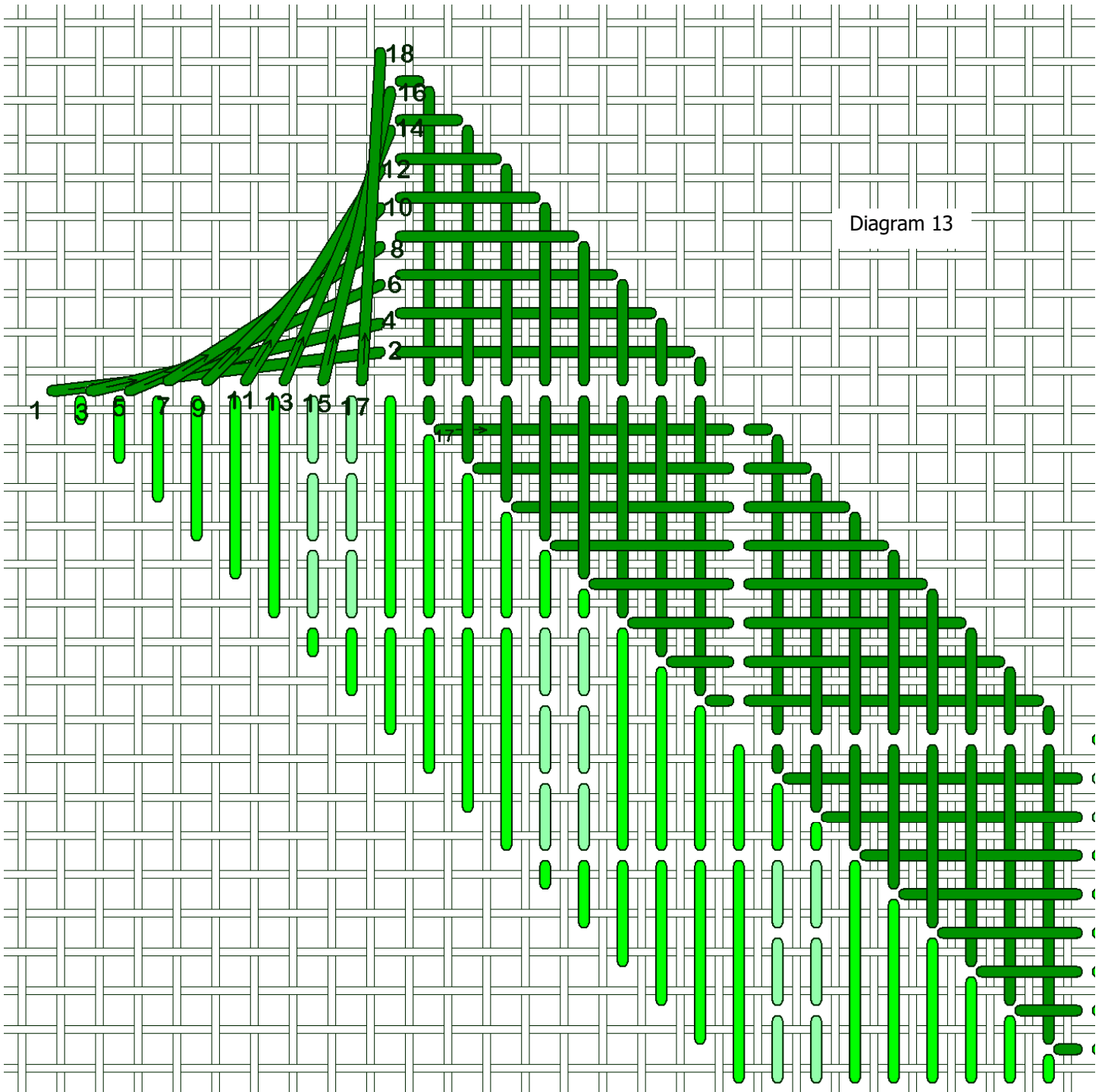
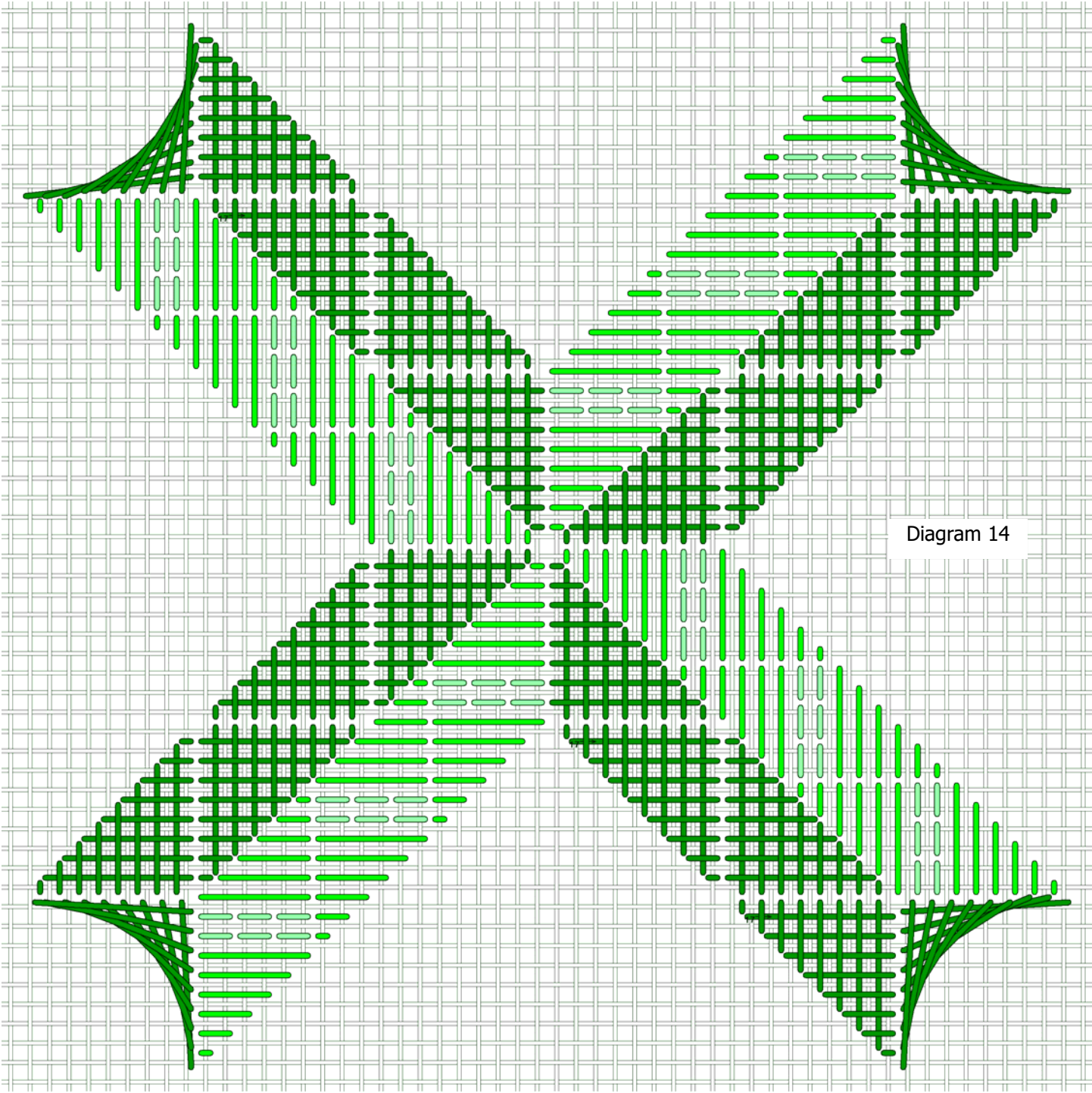




This is where to stitch the first part of the Jessica.



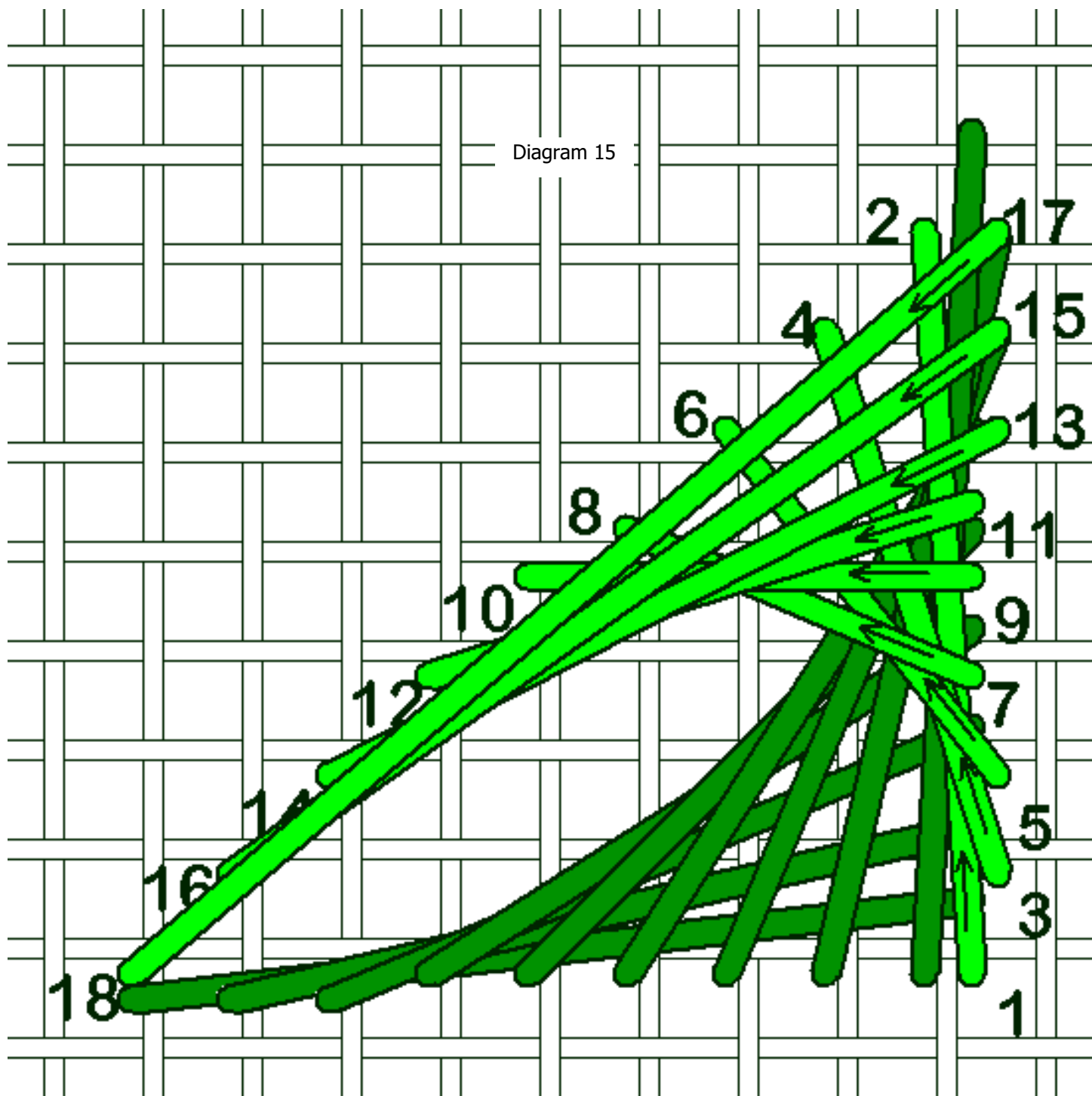
Turn the canvas to stitch this part on all four angles.



For the next part, use 2 strands of S906 Medium Pistachio Green. So far so good—nothing complicated!

The stitches begin where the previous stitches ended, in shared holes.

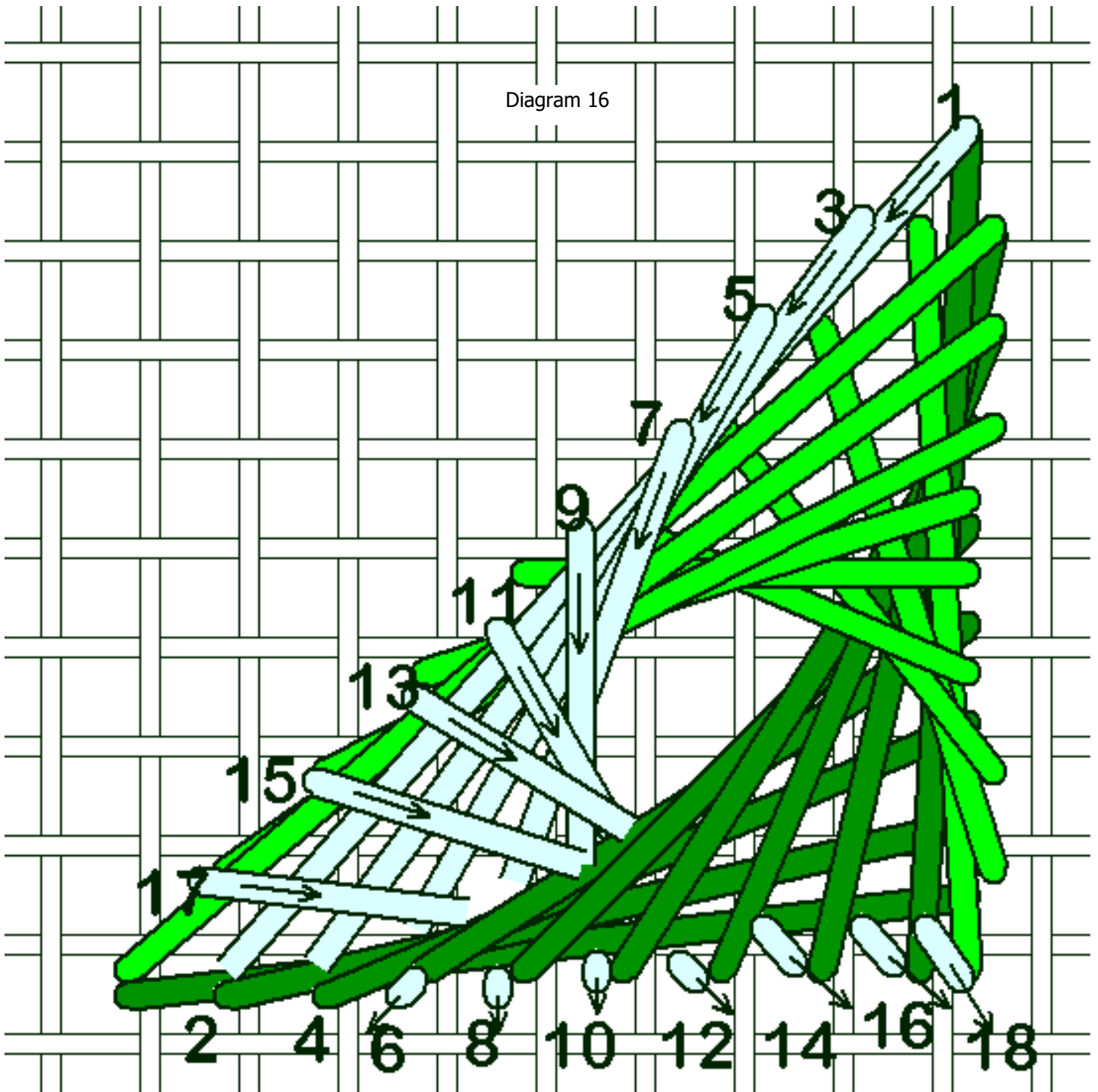

Turn the canvas to stitch the next part on all four sides.

The last part is where it gets a little trickier, but it's not hard! Use 2 strands of S905 Light Pistachio Green to stitch the last part.

Each stitch begins where a previous stitch ended, and ends where a previous stitch began. Before ending the stitch, slide the needle between the canvas and the previous stitches. This will be under all of the stitches (except the first one) with the darkest color.



Sliding the needle between the previous stitches and the canvas makes the Jessica look like there isn't a beginning or ending, which gives it a more interesting look.
